In accordance with Texas Transportation Code, §501.099, if you are not a resident of the United States, you may only purchase a nonrepairable or salvage motor vehicle from a salvage vehicle dealer or a governmental entity. The seller must obtain a legible copy of your photo identification, issued by the jurisdiction where you reside.
